#### **Beautiful Eucharist - Matthew Kelly**

Let's finish up looking at the book Beautiful Eucharist. The Conclusion is: Get Close and Stay Close, by Matthew Kelly.

Matthew Kelly asks these questions, "What's the most Beautiful church you have ever been in? How did it make you feel?" Matthew's experience was limited to his parish, St. Martha's in suburban Sydney. When Matthew started to travel he realized the world is full of beautiful Catholic churches. Matthew writes, "Stand in St. Peter's Basilica in Rome, Notre Dame or Sacre Coeur in Paris, St. Mary's Cathedral in Sydney, Duomo Cathedral in Milan, Las Lajas Sanctuary in Columbia, St. Patrick's Cathedral in New York, the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, DC, or any of a thousand other incredible Catholic churches around the world and you will feel awe and a sense of the sacred." The real beauty is not in the architecture or history, not in just something, but someone. "That someone is Jesus Christ, truly present in the Eucharist, present in all these churches, and present in the tabernacle in your local church."

Matthew Kelly further writes, "All the answers are in the tabernacle. Jesus has all the answers and he patiently waits for us in the tabernacle, day and night to share those answers with us. Next time you are grappling with a decision, stop by your church and ask Jesus for his advice." Matthew Kelly concludes his reflection, "So here is my invitation to you: Stop by a church for ten minutes each day this week and spend time in the quiet. Sit before Jesus in the tabernacle." "Jesus awaits you in the Eucharist. Come into the silence and let Him change your life."

I hope you have enjoyed the journey through the chapters of the book *Beautiful Eucharist*. Allowing you some time to reflect on how the Eucharist has touched each of the authors in a unique way. Also reflecting on the fact that every tabernacle in every Catholic church in the world has the true presence of Christ in his body, blood, soul, and divinity. Maybe one of the reflections helped motivate you to spend some quiet time with Christ. To spend some time with a friend and just listen.
