Beautiful Eucharist – Bishop Andrew Cozzens

To continue to share the main message of the National Eucharistic Congress, let's continue to look at the book *Beautiful Eucharist. The 6th chapter is: Right Here, Right Now, No Other Place I'd Rather Be!* by Bishop Andrew Cozzens.

Bishop Andrew Cozzens serves the Diocese of Crookston. He has also worked as a traveling missionary, professor, and religious educator. He was appointed to lead the three-year National Eucharistic Revival. This reflection was adapted from Bishop Andrew Cozzens' keynote address at the 2022 Joshua Congress.

Bishop Cozzens opens his reflection with, "Why is it so important that we hand on the teaching of the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist? When someone experiences that Jesus is really present in the Eucharist, it helps them to understand what it means to be a disciple." A disciple is someone who loves the phrase "Jesus is Lord." Bishops Cozzens writes, "What does that mean? Jesus is the center of my life. Jesus is the first person in my life. And my life is directed toward him."

The world's vision of happiness is that everything is "right;" the right education, the right job, the right spouse, the right friends, and the right place to live. Bishop Cozzens writes, "Well, the problem is that I'm at the center, and I'll never get all that right, and no one of those things will ever satisfy me." The answer is to put Jesus at the center. Ask him the plans for your life, "What's the career you made me for? Who am I supposed to marry, if I'm supposed to get married? What's my vocation?"

Jesus' presence in the Eucharist makes a difference when you begin to sense His presence in your heart. He is the food that feeds our soul.

Point to Ponder: "Jesus wants to do something in your heart right now. Will you let him? Bring whatever uncertainty you are currently facing to Jesus in the Eucharist and ask: *Jesus, what do you think I should do?*"

Sister Mary DePaul Sabella, SSJ

In her 80th year of ministry, Sister Mary DePaul Sabella, SSJ, often is seen tending to the plants and flowers at the Sisters of St. Joseph Community Living Center in Erie, where she resides. Born in Crossingville, Pennsylvania, she attended Crossingville Grade School and received a religious education certificate from Mission Helpers of the Sacred Heart in 1952. She entered the Sisters of St. Joseph on August 15, 1945, from her home parish, St. Philip in Crossingville, and professed her final vows in 1950.

During her long service, Sister Mary DePaul ministered as a housemother at St. Joseph Home for Children in Erie and she served on the motherhouse support staff. She spent many years teaching religious education at Houtzdale Catechetical Center, Mercer County Catholic Center, Our Lady of Peace Parish in Erie, St. Francis Catechetical Center in Bradford, St. Agatha and St. Brigid parishes in Meadville and St. Patrick Parish in Erie. Sister Mary DePaul also served as a pastoral minister at St.

Michael, St. Ann and Immaculate Conception parishes in Erie, and she ministered in pastoral care at Saint Mary's Home of Erie.
