Precious Blood of Jesus

The month of July is dedicated to the Precious Blood. The Feast of the Precious Blood of our Lord was instituted in 1849 by Pius IX, but the devotion is as old as Christianity. The early Fathers say that the Church was born from the pierced side of Christ, and that the sacraments were brought forth through His Blood.



Thus, lets consider parts of a reflection written by Fr. Angelo Casimiro, MIC on the Precious Blood of Jesus:

"Devotion to the Precious Blood is centered on honoring and meditating upon the Blood that Jesus Christ shed during His Crucifixion for the redemption of humanity. This devotion emphasizes the profound spiritual significance of Jesus' sacrifice and the salvific power of His Blood. We believe that through the shedding of His Blood, Jesus offered Himself as a perfect sacrifice to reconcile humanity with God and to atone for sin.

The Precious Blood of Jesus is seen as the ultimate expression of God's love and mercy, as it was freely given for the forgiveness of sins and the salvation of souls.

This devotion is powerful because it is the ultimate expression of God's love and mercy toward us. It is a tangible sign of God's willingness to suffer and die for the sake of our salvation, demonstrating the depth of His love and compassion. Jesus' Blood represents the victory over sin and death achieved through His resurrection. By shedding His Blood, Jesus conquered the powers of sin and death, offering believers the hope of new life and reconciliation with God.

We believe that the Eucharist is the true Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. Through the Sacrament of the Eucharist, we receive the Precious Blood of Jesus, nourishing us spiritually and uniting us more closely to Christ. We believe that devotion to the Precious Blood has the power to intercede for believers and offer us protection from spiritual harm. We often invoke the Precious Blood for strength, healing, and deliverance from evil."

"Take time to meditate on the significance of Jesus' Precious Blood and its role in the redemption of humanity. Reflect on passages from Scripture that speak about the shedding of Jesus' Blood, such as Isaiah 53:5 and Hebrews 9:14.

In addition, regular participation in the Sacraments of the Eucharist and Reconciliation is essential to receive the graces made available through the Precious Blood of Jesus. Approach the Sacraments with a heart open to receiving God's mercy and forgiveness.

Lastly, use opportunities for evangelization to proclaim the good news of salvation through Christ's sacrifice and to invite others to experience the transforming power of God's mercy in their lives."

O Most Precious Blood of Jesus Christ, we honor, worship and adore Thee. Heal the wounds of our souls and wash away the sins of the whole world. O Precious Blood, have mercy. Amen."
