# April 6, 2025 - Fifth Sunday Of Lent

#### Fifth Week of Lent

So, how is your Lenten journey going as we move closer to Holy Week? When thinking about prayer, I am reminded of the importance of holy medals and associated devotions that can be used to bring us closer to God. I read an article from Catholic Answers about holy, devotional, or religious medals.



A religious medal usually resembles a coin created for devotion or commemoration. They can include images of the Blessed Virgin Mary, saints, a pope, or another Christian iconography. Holy medals have become a staple sacramental since the eighteenth century. They can also help us recall the mysteries of the Catholic faith and be tools to help us focus our prayer. Today medals are given and used for many purposes, including First Holy Communion, Confirmation, blessings for expectant mothers, and religious promises.

Now, look at two examples of the more widely known holy medals. One of the most famous and recognizable holy medals is the St. Benedict's medal, approved in 1880 for the 1,400-year anniversary of the founding of the Benedictine Order. The front has an image of Benedict with a cross in his right hand and the Rule of Benedict in his left. An image of a chalice and a raven are shown at his feet. This calls to mind Benedict's miraculous deliverance from poison. The reverse side of the medal contains several powerful Latin prayers written as initials.

The second example is St. Catherine Labouré's *miraculous medal*. In France, between July 18<sup>th</sup> and November 27<sup>th</sup>, 1830, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to Catherine and asked her to have a medal produced with exact specifications. Catherine was also to refrain from sharing the instructions with anyone but her priest; and remain anonymous. The priest had the medals struck, and he and Catherine kept the secret for forty-six years. Millions were later distributed within the first two years of its circulation. The many miracles attributed to this sacramental medal led to it being known as the *"miraculous medal."* 

The following quote from the article perfectly emphasizes religious medals' overall purpose, "Medals, as a sacramental, continue as wonderful means of exciting the faith of the wearers. In addition, they are a superb visual tool for evangelization."

May you receive all God's blessings as we continue our Lenten journey.


