Rerum Novarum

What is Rerum Novarum and what does it mean to us as Catholics? If you have been watching EWTN, listening to Catholic radio, or browsing various Catholic websites you have probably heard it mentioned.



Rerum Novarum serves as the cornerstone of modern Catholic social teaching. Issued by Pope Leo XIII on May 15, 1891. It was groundbreaking in addressing the struggles of the working class and societal changes during the Industrial Revolution. Our new Pope Leo XIV was quoted at his first address to the College of Cardinals, delivered on May 10, "Sensing myself called to continue in this same path, I chose to take the name Leo XIV for several reasons, but mainly because Pope Leo XIII in his historical encyclical Rerum Novarum addressed the social question in context of the first industrial revolution. Today the church continues to offer everyone the treasure of her social teaching in response to another industrial revolution and to developments in the field of artificial intelligence that pose new challenges for the defense of human dignity, justice and labor."

If Rerum Novarum is important to Pope Leo XIV, it is worth taking a closer look at the contents. The encyclical arose during a period of profound upheaval. Radical changes were taking place in politics, economics and society. Pope Leo XIII provided a balanced, moral vision that rejected extreme ideologies and emphasized the protection of human dignity.

Rerum Novarum can be summarized into eight key themes and messages:

- The dignity of work and workers
- The role of private property
- Rights and duties of capital and labor
- The right to form unions
- The role of the state
- The Church's role
- Rejection of socialism
- A call for collaboration

The rich content of this encyclical is worth unpacking further. Next week we will look at some of the details on the eight key themes. Hopefully this will provide inspiration for us to read Rerum Novarum and other papal encyclicals.
