The Rosary of the Most Blessed Virgin Mary, is prayed every Saturday at St. Lawrence Church, beginning at 4:30, just before the 5:00 Mass.

I read the book American and Catholic by C. Walker Gollar. It covers the timeframe from the fifteenth up to the twenty-first century. This week I would like to spend some time with the story of a saint from seventeenth-century North America.



This week on July 14<sup>th</sup>, the Church celebrates Saint Kateri Tekakwitha. Her mother was a Christian Algonquin taken captive by the Iroquois and given as wife to the chief of the Mohawk clan. Kateri Tekakwitha was born in 1656 in the Mohawk village of Ossernenon, just a few miles west of present-day Auriesville, New York. Her Mohawk name, Tekakwitha, means "she who bumps into things." Kateri was the daughter of Mohawk Chief Kenneronkwa. Her parents and bother died from a smallpox epidemic when she was only four. The young Tekakwitha survived but was left disfigured and half-blind.

In 1666, French soldiers took control of the area where Tekakwitha lived. French Jesuits followed but made little progress in converting the Iroquois people. Finally, in 1675, Father Jacques de Lamberville told nineteen-year-old Tekakwith about the joys of heaven. For someone who had suffered so much on this earth, words of a better life beyond must have brought great consolation. On Easter Sunday, 1676, Lamberville baptized Tekakwith. She took the name Catherine in honor of Catherine of Siena, the fourteenth-century saint the Jesuits had made popular among the native peoples. Catherine or Kateri lived a life of piety, prayer, and mortification. She died on Holy Thursday, April 1680, and the facial scarring from smallpox disappeared on this day. In 1980 Pope Saint John Paul II declared Kateri Tekakwitha blessed. Pope Benedict XVI canonized her on Sunday, October 21, 2012. Katerei is also know as "The Lily of the Mohawks."

This summer can provide a wonderful opportunity for a weekend trip to Our Lady of Martyrs – National Shrine of the North American Martyrs and birthplace of St. Kateri Tekakwitha. It can also be a restful break to walk were a saint walked.
